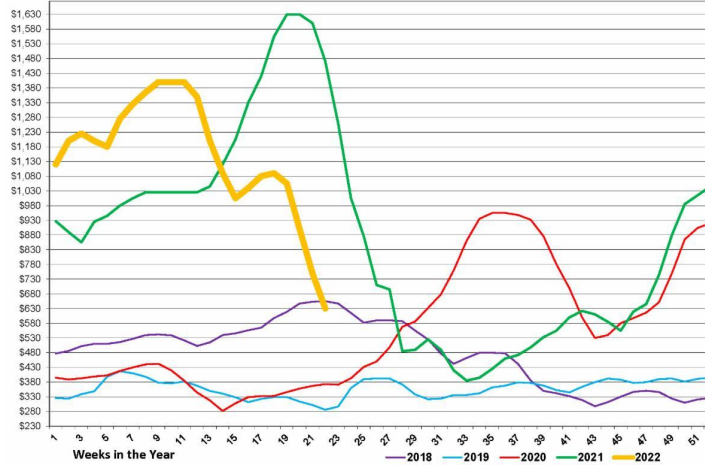




MARKET UPDATE - WEEK OF 6-06-2022

SPF

The market continues a downward trend. Trucking and rail cars continue to be an issue.

DOUGLAS FIR (DF)

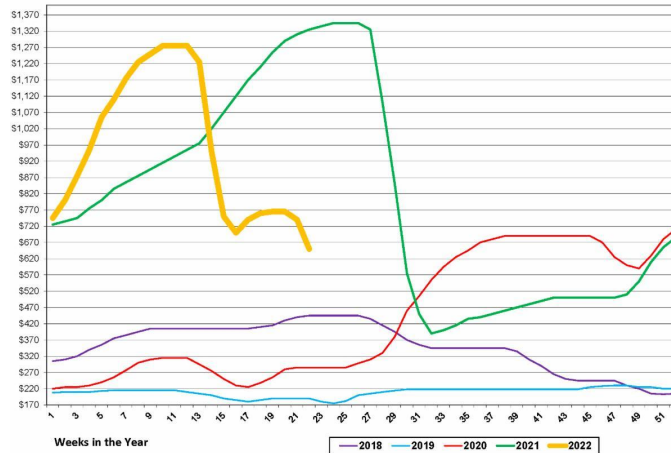
Prices have come down a little, but limited availability has slowed the decline.

TREATED LUMBER (SYP)

Prices continue a downward trend on 2x but not as much as in prior weeks. Decking is in a freefall and no indication of when it will slow. Timbers saw an uptick.

PLYWOOD

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OREIENTED STRAND BOARD (OSB)

Market moves downward. Trucking issues still hamper many producers' ability to release late loads. Continue to expect delays. To add fuel to the fire, today is the first day of the 2022 hurricane season.

SOUTHERN YELLOW PINE (SYP) PLYWOOD

The market continues downward. Logistics remains an issue.

DOUGLAS FIR (DF) PLYWOOD

The market has remained steady. Trucking continues to be a major issue and freight adders are increasing by the minute

ENGINEERED WOOD PRODUCTS (EWP)

Prices have leveled for now and should remain stable. Engineered still remains at a premium price. Material continues to be harder to source and material is on allocation from all suppliers.
